Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. Ephesians 5:17

Most Christians seek to know what God's will is for our lives, especially when we have important decisions to make. Personally, I can say that it is not easy. But nevertheless, what does help me find the peace of God is:

- Prayer
- · Reading his word
- · Meditate and reflect on the request that I have placed before the Lord.

James 5:16 "The fervent prayer of a righteous person has great power and gives wonderful results." The believer's prayer, as well as the reading of the Scriptures, are two of the most powerful weapons that every follower of Jesus Christ must always carry. Praying is talking to God. It is to tell Him the desires of our hearts, it is to plead our cause before Him and share with God our desires, and worries, joys, and frustrations. When we pray fervently, we touch the heart of God - not for our will to be done - but for his. Fervent, faith-filled prayer gives us the comfort, peace, and love of the Father as we wait patiently in his will. And when we read the Scriptures, we hear the voice of God. I tell you that in my experience as a believer in the Gospel, my prayer does not stop mentioning biblical verses or biblical stories that remind me that the God of Daniel (as well as the God of the woman who dared to touch the edge of Jesus' tunic) is the same yesterday, today and always, and he is the same God to whom I raise my prayer in search of his will. It is important that we also meditate/reflect on each request that we put before the Lord because it is my belief that God already gave us the ability to distinguish between what brings glory to God and what does not fulfill this purpose.

It is my prayer that this year, as the church of Christ perseveres in seeking and doing the will of God, we remember these two things, first, that everything that is contrary to love, compassion, grace and forgiveness, is not God's will. That God's will is to do every work, word and behavior that glorifies his name and invites our neighbors to want to do the same.

#### **LENTEN OFFERING**


