## LETTERS FROM THE PASTORS

Dear Ramsey Saints,

There seems to be an inherent leisurely pace that has a way of injecting itself into summer days. During summer we may be even busier than we are in the colder, winter months when we are inside and unable to be as active. But still there just seems to be a built-in leisure to the days of summer. Whether we are swinging in a hammock, sipping on lemonade, resting in the shade of a tree, or for many of us, sticking our toes in the ocean, there is a calmness that permeates those times. For some, it will be a vacation away during these next few months. For others, it may just be shady afternoons on a screen porch. But however, and whenever we find ourselves able to take a little break, breathe a little deeper and just enjoy the moment, it invites us to the rest that God calls us to share in. creating for six full days, God takes time to then rest. Was God tired? Did God need sleep? No and no. What God did was to model for us what it is to stop, reflect, and soak in where we are in the moment. It is a beautiful example of rest that God creates all the world and then takes a day to just look at all God has done. Genesis 1:31-2:3 tells it this way: "Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good! And evening passed and morning came, marking the sixth day. So, the creation of the heavens and the earth and everything in them was completed. On the seventh day God had finished his work of creation, so he rested from all his work. And God blessed the seventh day and declared it holy, because it was the day when he rested from all his work of creation."

It is wonderful to take a physical rest. But God also knows we need inner rest not just external rest to be at our best. God offers us that internal rest through a promise that Jesus spoke to his disciples just before he was to leave them. In John 14:27 we hear: "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid." My prayer for us Ramsey Saints is that as we take a physical rest on a summer afternoon, that every moment will be infused with a peace of mind and heart, a peace that passes all understanding that will keep our hearts not troubled and keep us not afraid. The God, who created us, gives us that peace. Let us rest in it!

Very often, the Lord works through ways that for human reasoning seem impossible, and that same reason seems to be shouting, you are a dreamer; you have such an absurd faith. But how good it is to let ourselves be led by the Holy Spirit and wait for what seems to be absurd. God always keeps his promises, and for our part, all that we can do is believe, believe in the one for whom everything is possible.

As a denomination, we are going through defining moments and historical moments. And it is in moments like these where waiting on God is all that we need to do. Once again, the annual conference is ready to meet. Things will not be the same, but despite all, we continue to believe and trust that God has everything under control and that only with Him and through Him everything is possible, whatever that means. Let's keep moving toward that place where God wants us to be. Let's keep on believing that faith usually appears where it is least expected. Let's keep on believing. Let me say it again, let's keep on believing and witness how the uncertain becomes certain and how the "strange" becomes familiar. Faith appears when the least expected. God is always in control.




