Dear Ramsey Saints,

When the wheels on the school buses start to turn there always comes a settling into more routine and structure after the lazy, less structured days of summer. This happens whether we have students on those buses or not. As we do that this year, Ramsey continues to live into a new governance structure for our church – the missional, educational, disciplemaking and administrative aspects of our life together.

Then instruct them in the practice of all I have commanded you. I'll be with you as you do this, day after day after day, right up to the end of the age."


